Trainee Exchange for Young Professionals

Switzerland - Australia

Young Swiss professionals have the unique opportunity to gain professional and trade skills and to improve their linguistic knowledge in Australia for up to 18 months under the trainee exchange agreement between Australia and Switzerland which offers a streamlined immigration process.

Candidates must

- Be 20-30 years old
- Be a Swiss citizen
- Receive workplace based training in an eligible profession or trade and technical occupation as defined in Major Groups 2 and 3 of the Australian and New Zealand Standard Classification of Occupations (ANZSCO)
- Have skills to the Australian standard for their occupation
- Receive a salary aligned with the applicable Australian Industrial instrument which applies to the position and/or workplace in which the candidate will be employed

Procedure

The prospective Australian employer completes the required statutory declaration and sends it to the Australian Department of Employment. The Department of Employment then advises the employer whether the statutory declaration meets the requirements of the MoU. If this is the case, the employer provides a copy of this advice to the candidate. The candidate can then apply for an International Relations Visa (sub class 403) through the Australian Embassy in Berlin.
