CV of Ambassador Reto Siegfried Renggli

Ambassador Reto Renggli was born 1969 in Lucerne, Switzerland. He started his professional career in the financial sector before joining the Swiss Federal Department of Foreign Affairs in 1991. He completed his training in Berne and Vancouver.

Following postings in Stuttgart and Bonn, Germany, Mr. Renggli was detached to Switzerland Global Enterprise in Zurich in 2001, where he was co-responsible for developing the new worldwide external network of the official Swiss Export, Import and Location Promotion Agency. In 2002, he built up the Swiss export promotion bureau at the Embassy of Switzerland in Warsaw, Poland, which he directed until 2007. Subsequently, he was appointed Swiss Consul General in Edinburgh, United Kingdom, with geographical responsibility for Scotland, Northern Ireland and the Isle of Man. From 2011 to 2015, Mr. Renggli acted as Head of the HR-Resources Planning Department in the Direction of Resources in Berne. Between July 2015 and August 2019, he served as Swiss Consul General in Hong Kong, with consular district for the Special Administrative Regions of Hong Kong and Macau and in October 2019, he took over the function of the Director of the Trade Office of Swiss Industries in Taipei. Since July 17, 2023, Mr. Renggli is Ambassador of Switzerland to the People's Republic of Bangladesh in Dhaka.

Mr. Renggli completed his initial formation in banking with studies in European Business Administration and holds a Master of Advanced European Studies from the University of Basel.

Mr. Renggli has two daughters. His spouse currently lives in Hong Kong.
