This is what we contributed to the economic development and employment sector in 2023

- New and better jobs for 2,388 young people (43% of women)
- Growth of private investment in supported enterprises reaching BAM 10 million
- Introduction of an online business registration system in the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina



This is what we accomplished in the health sector in 2023

- 98% of users of community nursing in 22 primary health care centres satisfied with the services
- 72% of community mental health centres (out of 74 in total) provide quality services in accordance with the accreditation standards
- 3,003 elderly people (68% of women) received innovative home-based care provided by auxiliary nurses in 10 municipalities



These are the results of our support to local governance and municipal services in 2023

- 62 municipalities in Bosnia and Herzegovina improved their work and cooperation with citizens
- 140,659 citizens benefited from improved municipal infrastructure
- 1,730 citizens participated in defining priorities for investments in their local communities
