

## Birth of a child in Liberia to parents who are not married: entry in the Swiss civil status register

Documents to submit
□ original birth certificate of your child
□ original official decree establishing filiation or recognition of paternity (if not clearly mentioned on the birth certificate, a jugement of the competent court with mention of date and place of recognition has to be presented)
☐ in case of late registry the original judgement is required
For the parent who do not hold Swiss nationality and are not yet registered in the Swiss civil status register, please submit the following:  □ original birth certificate
☐ in case of late registry the original judgement is required
<ul> <li>original civil status record at the time of your child's birth:</li> <li>a) certificate establishing that they are unmarried (certificate of non impediment or of bachelorhood/spinsterhood)</li> <li>b) divorce judgement that specifies when it entered into force</li> <li>c) dissolution decree that specifies when it entered into force</li> <li>d) certified true copy of death certificate of deceased spouse/partner</li> </ul>
□ original certificate of current residence (address certificate delivered by Commissioner's office or affidavit)
□ copy of passport
For the parent who do hold Swiss nationality and/or living in Switzerland, please submit the following:  □ copy of passport
a copy of pacoport
The original documents are submitted to the civil status authority concerned in Switzerland and must not be older than six months. They will not be returned. Photocopies are not accepted. Additional documents may be required if necessary.
Legalisation

All foreign civil status documents must be legalised with the Apostille of the Hague Convention of October, 5<sup>th</sup> 1961, before being submitted to the Swiss representation
