MONGOLIA

General Security Rules:

- Upon or prior to your arrival, please fill in the Emergency Contact form, provided by the SCO Office Manager, which includes your insurance details and important contact numbers in case of an emergency.
- Upon arrival in Ulaanbaatar, please leave a copy of your passport at the reception.
- The Office Manager will give you an emergency card with important phone numbers. Keep it with you at all times.
- Leave your travel schedules and contact numbers with the Office Manager. Maintain good communication with the people you work with. Always let someone know where you are going, and when you are expected to be back.
- Always carry a copy of your passport with you. Leave your passports, air tickets, personal valuables, etc. in the safe in your hotel or at the Swiss Consulate (at your responsibility).

General Security

Recommendations:

Valuables

- Banks, ATMs and registered money changers are available in all urban areas. Limited foreign exchange is available in the remote soums. Change enough money before going to the countryside.
- Do not carry large amounts of money with you if necessary
- Be aware of pickpockets and jacket snatchers in crowded

areas, such as markets, bars, entrances, department store.

Valuables Back-Ups

- Daily back-up your work related documents. Backed-up files need to be stored separated from your laptop.
- Documents on the office PCs are automatically backed up.

Travel and walking around

- Public transportation is ok to use. Fees are paid inside. Avoid crowded buses.

Food

- It is safe to eat cooked food. When visiting families in the countryside, it is polite to taste (take a sip of milk tea, a piece of candy, etc.) what is offered to you, even if you do not want to eat.
- Be careful when eating food with eggs and mayonnaise, especially in summer and in location with limited or no refrigeration.

What to do if YOU face an emergency?

-1- Keep Calm

-2- Get as much information as possible about what is happening.

-3- Inform SCO office – 33 14 22 or 9975 1123 (available 24 hour)

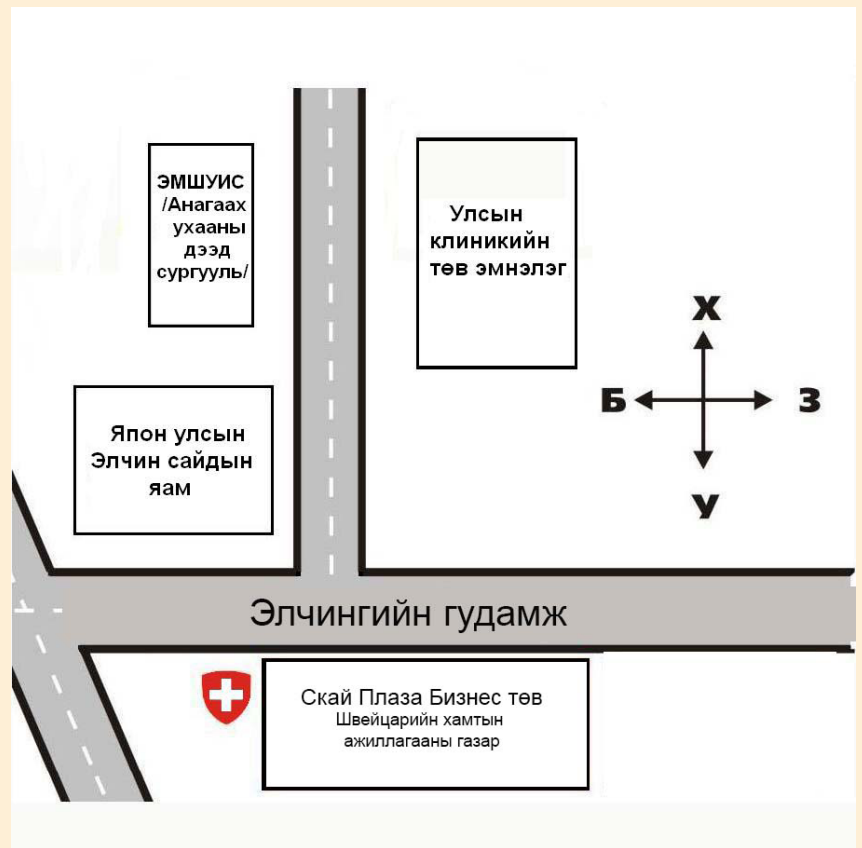
