# ☐ Original death certificate with Apostille

- issued within the last 6 months. If the document is older, a new document must be ordered
- legalised with an Apostille
- photocopies, scans or certified copies will not be accepted
- will <u>not</u> be returned to you

Swiss identity documents of the deceased (passport and identity card), if applicable.
The cancelled documents can be returned for commemorative purposes if the family requests this
when submitting them.

## **Translation**

Documents that are not in a Swiss national language or in English must be translated.

## **Fees**

Registration of the death in the Swiss civil status register is free of charge.
