

SCHENGEN C VISA - FAMILY / FRIENDS VISIT

Processing your visa application

- Book an appointment by e-mail to <u>abuja.visa@eda.admin.ch</u> (see also <u>"how to book an appointment"</u>).
- Visa applications are received every morning (except Fridays), from 8.30am.
- Processing a Schengen visa application takes at least 15 days (no fast tracking available).
- Applicants must appear at the Embassy in person.
- Failing to bring all required documents will result in having to book a new appointment.

Fees

The visa fee can be paid by POS or in cash (NGN) during the appointment. Please check the exact visa fee on our <u>website</u> before the appointment.

In case of a refusal or a withdrawal of the application, the visa fee will not be refunded.

Documents to submit (additional documents might be requested)

One Schengen application form	duly filled-in (application forms are free of charge).
Passport	valid at least three months after leaving the Schengen area and with at least two blank visa pages; please additionally submit all previous passports, either valid or cancelled.
One photocopy of identification page of passport	
Copy of all Schengen, UK, US and Canadian visas	if applicable
Copy of the Nigerian residence permit	For non-Nigerian nationals residing in Nigeria only
Two passport photographs	in color, 35x45 mm, white background, not older than 3 months, good quality. Head coverings are not permitted except for religious reasons.
Letter of invitation from the host in Switzerland and Copy of Swiss residence permit or Swiss passport / ID card of the host	must contain: name, first name, date of birth of every invited person, purpose and duration of visit (exact dates of stay in Switzerland), cost guarantee and confirmation of applicant's accommodation (if applicable).
	The host in Switzerland must additionally send the invitation letter by email to: abuja.visa@eda.admin.ch as a PDF, duly signed and dated, with a copy of his/her passport data page containing the signature + if applicable a copy of the Swiss residence permit.
	If the host works for an international organization or diplomatic mission in Geneva or Bern: ➤ good quality copy of valid "carte de légitimation"

	 confirmation of employment signed by the international organization or diplomatic mission
If not hosted	hotel/accommodation reservation in Switzerland
Proof of employment / income	➤ If self-employed: introduction letter (mentioning who will cover the costs for entire trip); business incorporation certificates and memorandum, original (to be returned) and photocopies; company bank statement and personal bank statement for the last 3 months, stamped and signed by the bank.
	➤ If employed: introduction letter from the employer with indication of the start date of employment, the annual salary, the granted leave period, the resumption date and mentioning who will cover the costs for the entire trip; salary slips for the last 3 months; personal bank statement for the last 3 months, reflecting salary slips, stamped and signed by the bank.
	If unemployed or retired: introduction letter with indication of source of livelihood; personal bank statement for the last 3 months, stamped and signed by the bank.
Hotel reservation	or confirmation of accommodation
Preliminary ticket booking	A flight reservation is sufficient. It is not recommended to buy a ticket before the visa has been granted. The Embassy cannot be held responsible in case of delays or visa refusal.
Proof of international travel	The insurance shall be valid throughout the territory of
insurance	the Schengen Member States and shall cover the
	entire period of the intended stay or transit. The minimum coverage is EUR 30'000
Marriage Certificate	If married. Original and one photocopy.
marriage Certificate	The original will be returned.
 L	The original will be retained.

Minors (under the age of 18 years old)

Both parents (respectively legal guardian(s)) must sign the visa application form (original signatures only).

Birth Certificate	Original and one photocopy
Both parents' passports	Copy of the data pages.
Consent letter	dated and signed, from both parents. If one of the parents is absent or deceased: court decision or a death certificate when applicable. If the legal guardian is someone else apart from the parent as stated in the birth certificate: custody order (Affidavits not accepted) proving the legal guardianship.
Original letter from school	containing the minor's name, name of parents, grade, confirming leave to travel with exact travel dates.
Complete list of names	If the minor travels with a group: a complete list of names of all group members travelling, name of person in charge of the group and confirmation of sponsorship for the trip and entire stay.
