

Check-list: Airport Transit visa / category C

Important: all of the listed documents have to be submitted in person

1 one completed visa application form (www.swiss-visa.ch), duly signed by the applicant	
The form must imperatively be printed and brought to your appointment!	
2 Passport	
valid for at least three months beyond the planned stay in Switzerland, at least 2 empty pages + previsous passports	
3 Copies of personal information in passport and copies of previous Schengen visa	
4 Two recent passport-size photographs with white background	
5 Airline ticket reservation (for the entire journey)	
Do not buy the airline ticket. The Embassy cannot be held liable if your visa is refused)	
6 Copy of the visa to final destination	
7 For Foreigners residing in Gambia: resident permit for Gambia	
with a minimum validity of three months after return to Gambia	
8 Minors	

- Authorization to leave the territory signed by both parents and legalized by the police station, accompanied by a copy of their identity card also legalized by the police station, visa application form signed by the parents and mention father / mother, first and last name next to each signature, mandatory presence of the parents at the ticket office on the day deposit with the minor
- The birth certificate
- Certificate of (pre) school registration covering the period of the planned stay
- Parents' banking extracts for the last 3 months
- Indication of parents' profession and supporting documents on their income

Please note that other documents might be requested

all original documents have to be submitted with a copy. Originals will be given back to the applicant whereas copies remain in the visa

Processing time

You can file your visa application at the earliest 6 months before the planed travel to Switzerland. Processing time is about 5 to 7 days but can be longer. The appointment list usually being booked solid for two weeks, you should start your application at least one month before traveling.

Visa fee: To be paid in cash and in FCFA at the counter

Adults and children above 12 years: € 80 Children between 6 and 12 years: € 40

In accordance with Art. 25a of the Visa Code (cooperation on the readmission of irregular migrants) and based on a report of the European Commission, Schengen area Member States decided to temporarily adopt an implementing decision with respect to The Gambia.

Visa free of charge for:

Children below 6 years

Spouse or partner of UE or EFTA citizen. (marriage certificate has to be submitted)

Holders of diplomatic and service passports on official mission
