Processing time

You can file your visa application at the earliest 6 months before the planned travel to Switzerland. Processing time is about 5 to 7 days but can be longer. The appointment list usually being booked solid for two weeks, you should start your application at least one month before traveling.

Visa fee: To be paid in cash and in FCFA at the counter

Adults and children above 12 years: € 82

Children between 6 and 12 years: € 42

In accordance with Art. 25a of the Visa Code (cooperation on the readmission of irregular migrants) and based on a report of the European Commission, Schengen area Member States decided to temporarily adopt an implementing decision with respect to The Gambia. Visa fee was increased to 120 EUR.

Visa free of charge for:

Children below 6 years

Spouse or partner of UE or EFTA citizen. (marriage certificate has to be submitted)

Holders of diplomatic and service passports on official mission
