

## Check-list: Study visa, long term visa / category D

3 x visa D application form (Application for National Visa for Stays of more than 3 months) duly completed and signed by the applicant

2 Passport			
valid for at least six months beyond the planned stay in Switzerland, at least 2 empty pages + previsous passports			
3 Three recent passport-size photographs with white background			
4 Letter of acceptance of the coosen school or university in Switzerland			
5 Curriculum Vitae			
6 2 x set of previous school certificates/diplomas (certified by a notary and translated into French, German or Italian)			
7 Signed study plans, including why you decided to study in Switzerland and what you expect for your career			
Signed future plan, including educational and professional achievments planed after having finished the studies in Switzeralnd, explanation on how the student is going to benefit from the studies in the future			
9 Proof of sufficent financial means (e.g. bank statements, bank certificates)			
10 Written confirmation to leave Switzerland after completion of studies			
11 For Foreigners valid resident permit			

Please note that other documents might be requested all original documents have to be submitted with two (2) copies, Originals will be given back to the applicant whereas copies remain in the visa file.

Processing time: the application has to be submitted <u>at least 3 months (e.g. as early as possible) before the school/university starts</u>.

The application will be forwarded to the compentent Swiss authorities for their decision (8-12 weeks at least).

Visas for students with the purpose of study or training in Switzerland are free of charge.
