

Information sheet Wy Online-ID Loading / unloading goods in Switzerland





REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

0. How to get started

- > Only applicants with a valid legal status in Serbia (residence permit) can apply for a Schengen visa at the Swiss Embassy in Belgrade.
- ➤ The applicant must fill in the online visa application form www.swiss-visa.ch and print it out.
- > The applicant must request an appointment by e-mail belgrade.visa@eda.admin.ch with his online ID and a copy of passport.
- Appointments cannot be changed nor transferred to another person.
- The applicant must appear in person.
- > All documents issued in a local language must be translated into a Swiss official language (German, French, Italian) or in English.
- Appointment booking is free of charge
- The Embassy does not collaborate with agencies.

Documents

	Copy of all pages of the current and the previous passport. For non-Serbian/Montenegrin citizen: valid Serbian residence permit (original + 1 copy). Proof of health travel insurance valid for the entire stay and covering the whole Schengen area. The insurance must cover the minimum amount of € 30'000 as well as repatriation expenses to the home country. Only health travel insurances issued by an
	insurance in the Schengen area, in Serbia or in Montenegro are accepted. Terms and conditions of the insurance must be attached and translated if in a foreign language.
	Confirmation of registration at the mandatory social insurance (MA form) original + translation. For employed drivers: Confirmation of employment issued by the employer on company letter-head paper with the following information:
	- Name, first name, date of birth, nationality and passport number of the driver
	 Starting date of employment + indication whether employment is for a fixed or indefinite period. Names of companies in Switzerland with which the employer has a relationship.
	- Detailed information on the purpose of the stay in Switzerland and the type of goods transported.
	- The confirmation must be duly dated and signed by an authorized person.
	For self-employed who act as drivers themselves:
	 copy of the extract from the commercial register (APR) + with translation. Written confirmation from the partner company in Switzerland containing the driver's personal details (surname, first name, date of
	birth, nationality, passport number), duly dated and signed.
	Valid driving license in original + copy of both sides.
ш	International Consignment Notes (CMR). Minimum of one CMR per month for the last 6 months (CMR must be dated, legible and bear the customs clearance stamp) and/or transport orders.
	Visa is free of charge.
II.	Before attending the appointment
	The documents must be submitted in the same order as on this sheet.
	Make sure that all documents in a local language are translated into a Swiss official language (German, French, Italian) or in English
	even if it is not specified on this sheet. Illegible documents will be considered invalid and therefore missing.
ā	The passport photo must meet the <u>requirements</u> , if not, the application will not be accepted.
	Make sure that all submitted documents contain all requested information before submitting your application.
	Visa applications and required documents must be complete, filled in and signed before arriving at the counter. There is no time
	available to fill in forms at the counter.
	If incomplete, the application will not be accepted and it will be necessary to book another appointment (no emergency

appointments available).

- · Processing time is 7 working days at the earliest.
- The personal presence of the applicant is not necessary to collect the passport.

Please be aware that the Embassy of Switzerland:

- Does not accept applications without prior appointment.
- Does not hold visa application pending while waiting for the missing documents.
- Does not inform about the status of the application during the examination
- Reserves the right to:
 - > request additional documents
 - > to set longer deadlines for the return of passports.
 - > transmit the application to authorities in Switzerland for decision/approval
 - summon the applicant for an interview
 - change this regulation without any prior notice
