



FAQ - Taxes in Thailand

Who can give me information on taxes in Thailand?

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Am I subject to taxation in Thailand?
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Taxpayers are divided into "residents" and "non-residents". You are subject to taxation in Thailand if you stay there for a total of 180 days or longer during a tax year. In Thailand, the tax year corresponds to the calendar year. https://www.rd.go.th/fileadmin/user_upload/lorkhor/newspr/2024/FOREIGNERS_PAY_TAX2024.pdf

Where can I obtain a tax identification number?
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The Tax Identification Number (TIN) must be requested to the Thai Revenue Department: https://www.rd.go.th/english/21987.html
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What is the deadline for filling my tax return?
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The deadline is always March 31.

In which language must the documents (bank account statements etc.) be submitted?
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The documents must be submitted in English or Thai. https://www.rd.go.th/fileadmin/user_upload/lorkhor/newspr/2024/FOREIGNERS_PAY_TAX2024.pdf
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Do the documents have to be certified by an official body?
