This document is issued by the Department of Health, Bureau of Vital Statistics, of the place of birth, or by the State Department of Health, Bureau of Vital Statistics, at the capital of the state in which the person was born. Please ask for a complete and certified copy of the birth certificate, which must show the place (town) of birth and the parents' full names, including the maiden name of the mother.

IMPORTANT

- 1. All documents (originals or certified copies) must bear the official seal. Documents issued by hospitals and churches and documents legalized by a Notary Public are not accepted by the competent Swiss authorities!**
- 2. The documents submitted to this office will not be returned. They will be translated, legalized and sent to Switzerland.**
