

## Schengen Visa

## Tourism / Visit / Business

Please note: only foreign residents and foreign students in the United States who have a valid permanent resident card or U.S. visa (e.g. categories F1 (I-20), H1B (I-797), G1, J1, I-512, etc.) may apply for a visa. If you have a B1/B2 visa, you must apply in your country of residence.

**Note for children (dependents) and spouses of Swiss and EU/EFTA nationals:** points 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13 do not apply. Instead, please include the following documents: Notarized copy of valid Swiss or EU passport of spouse/partner/parent and proof of family relation (marriage/birth certificate or partnership contract). Visa will be free of charge.

Please note that this is not an exhaustive list. If necessary, you may be requested to bring additional documents.

2	Passport photo  1 passport-sized picture (3.5 x 4 cm or U.S. standard-sized passport photo):  Color photo on a white background  Taken from the front; without obstruction  Recent (less than 6 months old)  Please find the exact requirements here. Digital files and photocopies will not be accepted.	
3	Original passport  Valid at least 3 months after departure from the Schengen area  Issued within the last 10 years  With at least 2 blank visa pages	
4	Copy of valid passport 1 photocopy of the passport (personal data page)	
5	Proof of residency in the United States  Notarized copy of Green Card  Copy of H1B / H4 / L1 visa + 1 notarized copy of I-797 / I-129S  Copy of F1 visa + 1 notarized copy of the I-20 with valid travel endorsement signature not older than 1 year  Copy of J1 visa + 1 notarized copy of DS-2019 with valid travel endorsement  Copy of A or G visa  Other proof:	
6	Copy of any previous Schengen visas (with copy of entry and exit stamps) issued within the past 5 years	
7	Copy of confirmed flight reservations in applicant's name  If the applicant is traveling to several Schengen countries, proof of intra-Schengen flights, train, or car rental bookings, including a travel itinerary specifying travel within the Schengen area.

8	<u>Tourism</u> : Accommodation reservation(s) in applicant's name covering every day of the stay in the Schengen area.	
	<u>Visit</u> : Visiting friends or family  Recent letter of invitation signed and dated from the host in Switzerland, indicating your full name, the dates, duration and purpose of the planned stay(s) in Switzerland, the relation to your host (family member, friend, etc.) plus name	
	address and contact information of the host.	
	Copy of host's Swiss passport or valid Swiss residence permit	
	Business:	
	Recent letter of invitation from the <b>host company in Switzerland</b> indicating applicant's full name as well as the dates, duration, and purpose of the planned business trip(s). If applicable, the inviting company should confirm that it will cover all expenses.	
	If attending a <b>conference</b> : nominal invitation from the organizer of the conference, mentioning the dates of the conference.	
9	Visa for the country you are visiting after leaving the Schengen area	
9	If requested, a valid visa in your travel document for the country you are visiting after leaving the Schengen area.	
10	<u>Tourism + Visit</u> : Proof of sufficient financial resources	
	Proof of sufficient financial resources: bank statements from last 3 months, listing your full name and address. A minimum of \$ 100 per day you are staying in the Schengen area is required (Students = \$ 30)	
11	Proof of employment	
	<u>Tourism + Visit</u> : Recent letter <b>from your employer</b> (stating your position and salary) or school (confirming enrollment).	
	If self-employed, 1 copy of business licenses and tax return	
	<b>Business:</b> Recent letter from employer in the United States, mentioning position and salary and, if applicable, stating that they guarantee expenses during the stay in the Schengen area.	
	Letter from your insurance company	
	company confirming international coverage of at least € 30,000 (appr. \$ 40,000) including:	
12	Emergency medical expenses	
	Emergency hospital treatment	
	Repatriation for medical purposes	
	Repatriation of mortal remains	
	If you do not have insurance or your insurance company cannot provide such a specific letter, you must purchase insurance for the entire duration of your trip and provide proof of purchase.

- The visa application must be submitted no more than 6 months prior to departure and no later than 15 calendar days before the intended start of the trip.
- An application without the complete documents as listed above may result in the refusal of the visa application.
