

## REQUIREMENTS FOR A VISA FOR STUDENTS National Visa D (more than 90 days)

The Embassy of Switzerland in Caracas requires the following documents in order to process your visa application:

1.	Original and 3 photocopies of passport (photo, personal data and signature page only), with at least three months validity and 2 blank pages	
2.	<u>Three (3)</u> national (type D) visa application forms duly completed in German, French, Italian, English or Spanish, signed by the applicant

3.	3 recent passport sized photographs (size: 35x45mm), on neutral background	
4.	Foreign nationals:	
	Resident permit with validity of at least 3 months of validity	
	(original and 2 photocopies)	
5.	Letter of admission to the university/school in Switzerland	
	(original and 1 copy)	
6.	Proof of payment of the Swiss university/school fees (original and 1 copy)	
7.	Curriculum Vitae (original and 1 copy)	
8.	Diplomas and certificates, along with translations if applicable	
	(original and 1 copy)	
9.	Motivation letter stating the objectives of the study, signed and dated by the applicant (original and 1 copy)	
10.	Letter of institution in case that all expenses for the study will be covered by scholarship (2 copies)	
11.	Confirmation of future accommodation in Switzerland. If the applicant will stay with family/friends,	
	we require a confirmation letter as well as a passport copy. If the host is not a Swiss citizen, then	Ш
	we additionally require a copy of the residence permit (2 copies)	
12.	Proof of sufficient funds for the planned duration of your stay (bank statements, bank certificates,	
	etc.)	_
	If sponsored: a signed and dated sponsorship letter will have to be submitted along with a copy of	
	the sponsor's passport (pages with photo, personal data and signature only) and his/her bank	
	statements (original and 1 copy)	
13.	Proof of languages skills such as TOEFL or IELTS certificates. German, French or Italian	
	language certificates, if available (2 copies)	
14.	Confirmation in writing that you will leave Switzerland after completion of the studies (2 copies)	

## Please note that:

- If necessary, you may be requested to submit additional documents.
- No copies are made on your behalf and incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- Depending on the school/university chosen, it is possible that the Embassy may have to evaluate the
  applicant's language skills with an oral and written test. In those cases, personal appearance is
  mandatory.
- Your request will be forwarded for a decision to the competent cantonal immigration authority where you intend to stay. The procedure takes at least 8 -12 weeks. This time is an approximation and may vary considerably depending on the canton responsible and the elements of the application.
