TRANSPORTATION

From Geneva Airport (GVA) and return

We recommend to use the complimentary shuttle service, provided by the Hilton Geneva Hotel & Conference Centre, which is available from and to the airport, daily from 4.20am to 11.40pm, every 20 minutes. Please follow the sign to the Hotel Shuttles – after customs to your right.

From Geneva Railway Station and return

Take BUS 5, direction "Genève-Aéroport, Terminal" and deboard at the station "**Grand-Saconnex**, **place**". The bus journey takes you about 15 minutes and runs every 10 minutes.

Alternatively, you can use BUS 60, direction "Ferney-Mairie" or "Gex- L'Aiglette" also till the station "Grand-Saconnex, place".

To return, BUS 5, direction "Thônex, Vallard" or BUS 60, direction "Gare Cornavin" brings you back to the city center.

BUS 5 and BUS 60 are also passing the United Nations, station "Place des Nations".



All participants staying at any hotel in Geneva can benefit from the Geneva Transport Card, free of charge. You will receive this card upon check-in at the hotel, which entitles you to free access to the entire public transportation network in Geneva during your stay.

HOTEL RESERVATION

A block of rooms has been secured at the Symposium venue, Hilton Geneva Hotel & Conference Centre, for use by Symposium attendees. The block reservation with your special rate **expires on 15th May 2024** We recommend that participants book their rooms at their earliest convenience.
