- In accordance with directives currently in force, the civil servant enjoys a courtesy period of two months after the termination of his/her employment. This courtesy period is granted automatically, without the express authorisation of the Swiss Mission.
- · A courtesy period of a maximum of three months may be applied, using this form, for a civil servant resident in Switzerland who is about to retire, to enable him/her to arrange its departure abroad or pending the granting of a Swiss residence permit by the Cantonal authority. Any other requests for courtesy periods must be submitted by the International Organisation, with a <u>detailed justification</u> of the request.
- During the courtesy period, the civil servant does not enjoy customs privileges.
